



Training opportunities

Extracurricular internships

They are reserved for people who have graduated from an Italian high school or university not more than 1 year prior to activation.

Applicants must have never had a contract with FBK in the past.

FBK may activate non-curricular internships when a promoter (University, accredited educational entities) exists, with which it enters into an Agreement and defines a Training Project.

The minimum duration is 2 months; the maximum duration is 6 months. Weekly hours may range from a minimum of 18 hours to a maximum of 38 hours.

Extracurricular internships provide for the recognition of an allowance, in line with Provincial Resolution 1953 of November 24, 2017, which amounts to €300.00 gross per month.

Training and Orientation Internships

They are aimed at unemployed individuals or first-time job seekers registered in an employment center in the province of Trento. The Employment Agency promotes training and orientation internships through its Employment Centers in order to implement the transition between study and work, to facilitate professional choices through direct knowledge of the world of work and job placement.

These opportunities are aimed at favoring the adaptation of the individual's working skills to the production context and business needs. They can be activated by the Employment Center at companies that make a request for personnel, when the figures sought are hard to find on the labor market and the proposed candidates are not suitable.

The Employment Center determines the duration based on the CV of the applicant (on average from 2/4 to 6 months).



Training opportunities

Professional internships

These are post-graduate internships required for accessing professional associations that are provided by some Universities in accordance with the Professional Associations, for example the Psychological Association. FBK accepts curricular internships upon an Agreement and a Training Project drawn up by the promoter and agreed upon with Fondazione Bruno Kessler. They have a standard duration of 12 months.

Internships for people with disabilities or disadvantages

These are workplace professional experiences for people registered in the provincial list of people with disabilities or disadvantaged people.

The internships can be integrated with theoretical training opportunities developed based on the indications of the host employers who collaborate in the implementation of the internship.

Internships aimed at people with disabilities have a maximum duration of 24 months, with the possibility of financing training for both internal and extra-company instructors.

Internships for people with disadvantages have a maximum duration of 12 months.
