The Center for Digital Society conducts interdisciplinary research aimed at exploring and understanding the interaction between **digital technologies** and the fabric of human society, creating the conditions for the former to be **catalysts for positive societal change**, promoting its sustainability, inclusiveness and resilience. Research particularly focuses on two key areas: **modeling and analysis of sociotechnical systems** to predict evolution and change, and **exploring the dynamics of new media and digital** solutions to innovate education and information.

The center collaborates with numerous **public administrations**, on strategic issues such as digitization, security, environmental sustainability and education. Finally, it collaborates with the University of Trento through joint workshops in the key areas for the center's activities (AI, sociology, psychology).

Among our projects is AI4TRUST, aimed at creating a platform that combines the input of artificial intelligence and that of expert fact-checkers to identify and report social media content and information sources at high risk of misinformation in real time.
