

Italian-German Historical Institute

The Italian-German Historical Institute promotes studies in the field of political, religious, social, cultural, legal and economic history in the modern and contemporary era, especially with reference to the Italian and German areas. We pay special attention to issues related to the urgent matters of our society (environment, mobility, media) and to new languages for communicating history (public and digital history).

The center has **one of the richest libraries specialized in the field of historical studies**. It boasts a **total holdings of more than 250,000 volumes**, with an annual increase of about 1,500 titles, and more than 2,200 periodicals, of which nearly 700 are current. Within it there are also preserved, in their entirety, a number of special fonds: scholarly libraries, libraries of agencies and institutions, the Ancient Books fond (1,340 volumes, including 145 cinquecentine).
