



Training opportunities

Extracurricular internships

These are aimed at individuals who have already obtained a diploma or degree from an Italian university no more than 1 year prior to the start of the internship.

The availability of the university of reference to act as the promoting entity for this initiative must be verified in advance.

The individual must not have previously had contracts with Fondazione Bruno Kessler.

The minimum duration is 2 months, the maximum is 6 months. The weekly hours can vary from a minimum of 18 hours to a maximum of 38 hours.

Extracurricular internships provide for the recognition of an allowance, in line with Provincial Resolution 1953 of November 24, 2017, ranging from €400 to €600 gross per month.

Post-graduate practical valiative internships

These are post-graduate internships required for access to professional orders provided by some universities in agreement with Professional Registers, for example, the Register of Psychologists.

It is possible to activate internships upon the establishment of an Agreement and a Training Project drawn up by the promoting entity and agreed upon with the Fondazione Bruno Kessler.

The duration is established by the university of reference.



Training opportunities

Internships for individuals at risk of unemployment or suspension

These are internships for the acquisition/enhancement of skills, aimed at reintegration or job retraining. They are mostly aimed at individuals at risk of unemployment or individuals suspended from work (e.g., in ordinary or extraordinary redundancy funds, ordinary and solidarity allowance provided by solidarity funds) registered with the Employment Center of the Province of Trento. They have a duration of between 8 and 26 weeks, upon evaluation by the Employment Center. They provide for an allowance of between €70 and €140 gross per week.

Internships for individuals with disabilities and disadvantages

These are professionalizing work experiences aimed at individuals registered in the provincial list of people with disabilities and disadvantages. They can last up to 24 months for people with disabilities and up to 12 months for people in disadvantaged conditions, upon evaluation by the Employment Center. They provide for an allowance of €70 gross per week.
